Mark McAfee, Keynote Speaker

Internationally recognized as an expert in raw milk production, Mark McAfee is well-known for both his pioneering activism and electrifying presentations. He will speak about the "two raw milks in America", raw milk food safety and CDC data, raw milk as medicine – particularly its healing effects on those with asthma – and raw milk's emerging political and marketing challenge to Pharma, Industrial Agriculture, confinement factory farms and dairy processors.

Mark is CEO and founder of Organic Pastures Dairy in California, the largest retail-approved, raw organic dairy producer in North America. He has spoken on the subject in fifteen states and three countries and is widely acclaimed for his industry leadership. Mark was awarded the 2005 Weston A. Price National Raw Milk Activist Award and in 2006 he addressed attendees at the International Slow Foods Conference held in Melbourne, Australia as the keynote speaker on raw milk issues.
