## Dear Mrs. Hulme:

It has come to our attention that you are engaging in the manufacturing and sale of dairy products at Evergreen Acres located at your property on Cadwaller Avenue in San Jose, CA. This correspondence is to notify you that it is unlawful to manufacture or process for resale any milk or milk product unless licensed by the California Department of Food & Agriculture. Your activities are in violation of several California laws and regulations.

Pursuant to California Food and Agriculture Code Sections 35011 and 35283, please be aware that the unlicensed manufacturing or processing for resale of any milk or milk product is a crime, punishable by a fine of up to \$10,000 and/or imprisonment of up to one year in the county jail.

Therefore, we urge you to take the following actions:

- 1. Cease all production of dairy products immediately.
- 2. Apply for a license from the Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA). Information on the licensing process is accessible on the CDFA website at www.cdfa.ca.gov.
- 3. Provide the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office with proof that you have applied for the license.
- 4. Do not manufacture or sell any dairy products until after you have received your license from CDFA.

Any further manufacturing, production, or sale of unlicensed milk products will result in this Office seeking appropriate action against you.
